RE: Sampling of Water Well JW-26,

Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA) collected groundwater samples from your well (JW-26) on 3/13/03. These samples were submitted to a laboratory contracted by CSSA's environmental contractor for volatile organic compound (VOC) analysis. This letter provides you with the VOC data from the laboratory results and a formal thank you for your assistance in this groundwater monitoring effort.

*The "F" flag indicates the value is above the laboratory method detection limit, but below the laboratory reporting limit for the compound.


Based on the analytical data, low levels of VOCs were identified in water samples from your well, but all concentrations are below drinking water maximum contaminant levels (MCLs). In addition, low levels of the VOCs naphthalene (0.07M ppb) and dichlorodifluoromethane (0.11M ppb) were detected. The "M" flag was generated due to a quality control check that was performed in the laboratory. Although these VOCs are not naturally occurring, these levels are below the applicable MCL for drinking water and as such, do not prevent usability of your well. Results from the laboratory analysis are provided as an attachment for the 3/13/03 event.

As part of the ongoing CSSA environmental program, we are continuing to investigate and cleanup VOC source areas on the installation and to track these compounds in groundwater on- and off-post. As part of this effort, we may contact you in the future to schedule another sampling event for your well listed above.
