

Dear Mr. Lentz:

The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), Red River Army Depot, Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command, Army Material Command, U.S. Army, has completed its' triennial sampling for lead and copper that occurred during the week of September 14, 2003. Samples were collected from Buildings 44, 90 (north), 91 (north), 98, and 201 and submitted to the Texas Department of Health for analysis. With the exception of Building 201, this is the same group of buildings that were sampled during previous lead/copper sampling events (1997 and 2000). Building 201 was substituted for Building 36, because personnel now occupy Building 36 around the clock, and it was not possible to stop water flow at this location for the required six hours prior to collection for an accurate lead/copper sample. The attached map depicts key drinking water sampling locations at CSSA and updates our sample site plan.
