CSSA letter dated May 19, 2004 - Request to resubmit maps

Dear Mr. Shirley:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your letter dated May 19, 2004 written in response to TCEQ letter dated March 24, 2004. Your letter responds to three comments and/or request for additional information specified in the TCEQ March 24, 2004 letter. In summary, the TCEQ requested additional information on: 1) metals concentration in off-post wells, 2) a trend analysis of groundwater concentration data in lieu of concentration and precipitation data, and 3) contaminant concentration maps for on-site and off-site groundwater data.

The TCEQ has reviewed your letter. For Item No. 1, a hard copy of Table 9 was enclosed with the report. CSSA submitted the requested information. In future submittals, please be advised that when presenting data that are available in the CSSA Environmental Encyclopedia (CSSA EE), a hard copy of the data should be submitted (or enclosed in the report) rather than just referencing the data in the CSSA EE. It has been the experience of the undersigned that accessing information in the CSSA EE has never been user friendly.

Item No. 2, CSSA had indicated that since December 2003, groundwater elevation measurement are being collected in two off-site drinking water wells (RFR-10 and LS-7) which were retrofitted to allow for groundwater elevation measurements. In the letter, CSSA had indicated that a trend analysis will be conducted on groundwater monitor well elevations and contaminant concentration level data. The TCEQ requests CSSA to submit the trend analysis when it becomes available and preferably submitted with the Off-Post Monitoring report.


Item No. 3, CSSA submitted the requested concentration maps for PCE, TCE and cis 1,2 DCE for June, September and December sampling events. The maps submitted were three maps per page which makes the resolution of the maps difficult to interpret. The TCEQ requests CSSA to resubmit the maps using one concentration map per page. Please resubmit the map within thirty (30) days of the date of this letter.

An original and one copy of the concentration maps must be submitted to the TCEQ at the letterhead address using mail code number MC-127. An additional copy should be submitted to the TCEQ Region 13 Office in San Antonio. Your response must be received on or before September 17, 2004. The facility name, location and the SWR No. 69026 should be included in your response.

To document compliance with the Texas Professional Geoscience Act, the Remediation Division will not review reports and documents received on or after September 1, 2004 that do not contain the seal of a Texas Professional Geoscientist for geoscience services and work. Reports and documents containing geoscience information that are not stamped with a Texas Professional Geoscience seal will be returned to the submitting party.
