The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), McAlester Army Ammunition Plant, US Army Field Support Command, Army Materiel Command, U.S. Army is submitting, as required by Section 106 regulations of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, the proposed demolition of Building 37. A brief description of the building and it's history are provided below. A map depicting the location and photographs of Building 37 are attached


Building 37 (Demolition)

Building 37 was designed in 1939 and built in 1937. Financing for the building came from a Works Progress Administration (WPA) grant. It was originally used as steam plant for renovation of ammunition cases. The steam plant also supplied heat to Building 37 and nearby Building 38. In more recent years it has been used for storage by the CSSA Public Works department for plumbing and electrical parts. A boiler, smoke stack, and UST associated with the building have been previously removed. The building is approximately 100 ft long by 25 ft wide rests on a concrete slab and is constructed of corrugated metal.

In accordance with Section 800.6 of the Section 106 Regulation, we are requesting that the State Historical Commission (SHPO) review our proposal and provide approval or comment at your soonest opportunity.
