The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), U.S. Army, is providing this response to your letter dated February 28, 2008.

Your February 28, 2008 letter requested additional information concerning the management of the incinerator ash. In particular, you asked whether the ash was sent to an off-site municipal or hazardous waste landfill. In addition, your letter requested the manifests for the waste disposal activity.

CSSA disposed of the AOC 55 Class 2 Non-hazardous contaminated media/waste, which was characterized in accordance with 30 TAC Chapter 335 Subchapter R, at Waste Management's Covel Gardens Facility (Covel Gardens) located in San Antonio, TX. Waste characterization analytical results can be found in Appendix A of the AOC 55 RCRA Facility Investigation/Closure Report in the CSSA Environmental Encyclopedia (www.stanley.army.mil/Volume1-3/AOC55/RFI/AppendixA.htm). Covel Gardens operates as a municipal and industrial non-hazardous solid waste landfill. Manifests generated from AOC 55 contaminated media and waste disposal are available for your review at CSSA.
