Dear Mr. Shirley:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed the review of the above referenced report. AOC-51 has a total area of approximately 29.2 acres. No evidence of waste management were found within AOC-51; however munitions and explosives of concern (MEC) were found during brush clearing activities in 1997. Excavation activities were conducted between April 17 and April 24, 2012 to remove soils with metal concentrations above the Tier 1 protective concentration levels (PCLs). A total of 1,300 cubic yards of contaminated soil was removed from different locations within AOC-51.

Confirmation samples indicated that no constituents of concern (COCs) were above the Tier 1 PCLs. A 95% upper confidence limit (UCL) was calculated for copper, lead, and zinc for the remaining soils at AOC-51 which did not exceed the Tier 1 PCLs for each COC. AOC-51 also passes the Tier 1 Ecological Exclusion Criteria Checklist.

CSSA requests no further action for AOC-51. Based on the information contained in the report, the TCEQ agrees that no further action for AOC-51 is needed. CSSA currently has approximately 88 on-site and off-site groundwater monitoring wells monitoring two chlorinated solvent plumes which originated from two sources not related to AOC-51.
