Dear Mr. Shirley:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed the review of the above-stated APAR for SWMU B-4. SWMU B-4 is approximately 2 acres in size. Trenches A, B, C, D, and NT1 were over-excavated, removing the affected soils and debris. Based on the report, the COC concentrations remaining in the surface and sub-surface soils at SWMU B-4 do not exceed Tier 1 or Tier 2 ^{GW}Soil_{ing} PCLs.

SWMU B-4 passes the Ecological Exclusion Criteria Checklist. Based on the information contained in the report, the TCEQ believes that no further action for SWMU B-4 is needed. CSSA currently has approximately 88 on-site and off-site groundwater monitoring wells monitoring two chlorinated solvent plumes which originated from two sources not related to SWMU B-4.
