




NOTE:
 NO MAGNETIC ANOMALIES WERE DETECTED IN CRATERS 11 OR 13. CRATER 13 CONTAINS WATER AFTER PERIODS OF PRECIPITATION. AT THE TIME OF THE MAGNETOMETER SURVEY, THE CRATER CONTAINED APPROXIMATELY 6 INCHES OF WATER.

 1352.7 ft. MSL = ELEVATION OF CRATER EDGE (CRATER 13)


