Monitoring Data


Dear Sir or Ma'am:

The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), Red River Army Depot, Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command, Army Material Command, U.S. Army, is providing this response to a letter dated June 11, 2004 regarding missing coliform data for April 2004. Per guidelines provided, we have issued the following notice to the installation residents and employees:

*CSSA was unsuccessful in its attempt to collect a quality bacteriological sample for coliform from the water distribution system during April 2004. Samples were collected and submitted to a laboratory for processing. However, the laboratory that the samples were submitted to were, at the time, not certified by state regulators to perform coliform testing. Coliform organisms were not found in previous nor subsequent samples taken. This monitoring is required by the TCEQ's "Drinking Water Standards" and the federal "Safe Drinking Water Act", Public Law 95-523. Bacteriological samples are used to monitor water quality and indicate if the water is free of coliform bacteria. Our water system is required to submit three bacteriological samples each month. Failure to collect all of the samples is a violation of the monitoring requirements and we are required to notify you of this violation.*
