Camp Stanley Storage Activity requests an extension to review draft permit conditions and to provide information as requested due to the Thanksgiving holiday which is upon us. We request that an additional 30 days be provided from 25 November 1995. CSSA will be increasing its limitation on solvent usage as follows:

<u>EPN</u>	<u>SOLVENT</u>	<u>USAGE</u> (gallons per year)	<u>PRODUCT</u>
1	Ferro Pack B VCI Solution	500	VCI
1, 2, 3	Mineral Spirits	1,500	Cold Solvents
4	Stoddard Solvent	500	Finger Print Remover

Also CSSA will be requesting flexibility in the solvent products used. We cannot identify what product(s) will substitute or replace the current solvents at this time due to federal procurement regulations. Modeling for the increased solvent usage is being calculated by Parsons Engineering Science, Incorporated. The modeling data will be provided as soon as it is available.
