Dear Mr. Shirley:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed the review of the above-mentioned report. SWMU B13 is a 1.4 acre site used for construction waste disposal consisting of concrete rubble, wire binding, bricks, etc. Approximately 7,480 cubic yards of debris and soil were excavated during the period from September through November 2012. A total of 18 confirmation samples were collected and sampled for VOCs, SVOCs, metals, and asbestos. Areas where contamination exceeded the Tier 1 PCLs were excavated and resampled.

According to the report, remediation was completed according to the TCEQ guidance: *Determining Which Releases are Subject to TRRP*. CSSA requests a "No Further Action" for SWMU B13. On the basis of information contained in the report, the TCEQ accepts the no further action for SWMU B13.
