
The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your letter dated September 26, 2005, pertaining to the implementation of the Long-Term Monitoring Optimization (LTMO) at Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA). As stated in your letter, CSSA requests approval from the TCEQ to implement the LTMO for the on-post groundwater monitoring only. CSSA will not implement the LTMO recommendation for the off-post monitoring wells until such time as the TCEQ has completed its review of the LTMO study submitted to the TCEQ on May 18, 2005. In addition to the recommendation of the LTMO for the on-post monitor wells, your letter also requested reductions in monitoring for a total of 39 monitoring wells and three drinking water wells. The location and well numbers of these wells are itemized in an email sent to the undersigned on November 3, 2005. Your letter further requests exclusion from monitoring the piezometers at or near the Area of Contamination No. 65. Also, it was requested that sampling be revised from monthly to semi-annually for the 47 groundwater zones in the four Westbay®-equipped multiport wells. For Westbay®-equipped wells, acetone and isopropanol be dropped from analyte sampling list. Lastly, you have requested the TCEQ expedite the review and comment of the September 25, 2005 letter in time for the December 2005 sampling event.

The TCEQ has reviewed your request. The TCEQ approves your request for reduced groundwater monitoring as itemized in the CSSA letter dated September 26, 2005. This approval is, however, effective only for the December 2005 sampling event. The TCEQ Remediation Division Technical Support staff is currently reviewing the LTMO recommendations submitted in May 2005. Depending on the outcome of the review, monitor wells that were scheduled for reduced monitoring in December 2005 may be returned for monitoring.
