Dear Mr. Lyssy:

In compliance with EPA guidance requiring a systematic planning process for environmental data collection activities, the Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), Red River Army Depot, Tank-Automotive and Armaments Command, Army Material Command, U.S. Army, maintains Data Quality Objectives (DQOs) for its' groundwater monitoring program. These DQOs conform to the *Guidance for the DQO Process* (EPA QA/G-4), and other related EPA documents concerning DQOs. Initial DQOs for the Groundwater Contamination Investigation were submitted to EPA and Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for review on April 22, 2002. No suggestions or comments were received and in August 2002, CSSA requested concurrence to proceed under the provisions of the DQOs beginning with the September 2002 quarterly groundwater monitoring event.

As quarterly groundwater monitoring proceeded, additional data evaluations and periodic reviews indicated that limited changes to the DQOs were necessary and led CSSA to revise the current DQOs. A preliminary version of the revised DQOs were submitted electronically on the CD Rom submitted to you on February 10, 2004. At this time, CSSA is formally requesting EPA and TCEQ review and comment on the DQOs. Also a copy of the DQO document is attached for your convenience and review. Please provide your concurrence by April 1, 2004.
