The RCRA Corrective Measures Study (CMS) Report, dated October 2014, for Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA) has been reviewed by the U.S. EPA (EPA) in accordance with the final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) § 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent for CSSA, Docket No. RCRA-VI 002(h)99-H FY99, dated May 5, 1999.

The purpose of the CMS was to screen and develop appropriate corrective measures alternatives for the removal, containment, treatment, and/or remediation of contamination identified at the Site. This information will be utilized in developing the Statement of Basis to ensure that human health and the environment are protected.

The CMS Report was well written and contains the information that is needed to develop the Statement of Basis. Pursuant to the EPA review of the CMS Report, it is hereby approved.
