Dear Mr. Shirley:

The RCRA Corrective Measures Design (*CMD*) Report, dated November 24, 2015, for Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA) has been reviewed by the U.S. EPA (EPA) in accordance with the final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) § 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent for CSSA, (Order) Docket No. RCRA-VI 002(h)99-H FY99, dated May 5, 1999.

The purpose of the CMD Report is to address the requirements necessary to implement the selected corrective measures at CSSA, as specified in the EPA Statement of Basis, and as approved in the EPA Final Decision Document. This includes: 1) Prevent or minimize migration of contaminants of concern (COCs) in groundwater within the source area at concentrations exceeding the MCLs and restore groundwater to its most beneficial use in a reasonable timeframe. 2) Prevent human exposure to groundwater containing COCs at concentrations that exceed MCLs in water supply wells. 3) Prevent on-site worker dermal contact and/or ingestion of COCs in shallow groundwater at concentrations exceeding acceptable human health risk values. The CMD meets the objectives and requirements of the Order and is hereby approved.
