Dear Mr. Shirley:

The *Construction Quality Assurance Plan (CQAP)*, dated August 16, 2016, for Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), has been reviewed by the U.S. EPA (EPA) in accordance with the final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) § 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent for CSSA, (Order) Docket No. RCRA-VI 002(h)99-H FY99, dated May 5, 1999.

The purpose of the CQAP is to ensure that completed corrective measures implemented at CSSA meet or exceed all design criteria, plans, and specifications required pursuant to the Order. This CQAP covers the three corrective measures utilized to address groundwater contamination at CSSA: 1) Enhanced Anaerobic Bioremediation (EAB) via a bioreactor, 2) In-Situ Chemical Oxidation (ISCO), and 3) Point-of-Use Treatment via granular activated carbon (GAC) filtration systems. In addition, groundwater monitoring, land use controls (LUCs), remedial optimization, and system operations and maintenance (O&M) are also included as part of the CQAP. Pursuant to EPA review, the CQAP is approved.
