The RCRA Corrective Measures Implementation Report, dated September 7, 2017, for Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA) has been reviewed by the U.S. EPA (EPA) in accordance with the final Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) § 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent for CSSA, (Order) Docket No. RCRA-VI 002(h)99-H FY99, dated May 5, 1999.

The purpose and objective of the Corrective Measures Implementation Report is to summarize the numerous on-going remedial actions at CSSA necessary to meet the Corrective Action Objectives (CAOs) as defined in the EPA Decision Document. The CSSA CAOs are: 1) Prevent or minimize migration of contaminants of concern (COCs) in groundwater within the source area at concentrations exceeding the MCLs and restore groundwater to its most beneficial use in a reasonable timeframe; 2) Prevent human exposure to groundwater containing COCs at concentrations that exceed MCLs in water supply wells; and 3) Prevent on-site worker dermal contact and/or ingestion of COCs in shallow groundwater at concentrations exceeding acceptable human health risk values.

This CMI Report meets the objectives and requirements of the Order, and is hereby approved.
