Subject: Project Review Under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1996, Proposed Demolition of Building 298, Camp Stanley Storage Activity, Boerne, Texas

Dear Mr. Brinkman:

The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), McAlester Army Ammunition Plant, U.S. Army Field Support Command, Army Materiel Command, U.S. Army is submitting this letter, as required by Section 106 regulations of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, for the proposed demolition of Building 298. A brief description of the building and the scope of work are provided below. Photographs and a map depicting the location of the building are attached.

Building 298 is a small building located immediately adjacent to groundwater wells CS-MW16-CC and CS-MW16-LGR, and near the northern boundary of the CSSA inner cantonment. Building 298 was built pre-1956, although the exact construction date is not known. Over the years, it has been used as a well house, a storage building, and a communication center for the CSSA Weather Station. There is currently a panel box servicing the wells and the weather station. Building 298 is proposed to be demolished due to its deteriorated state, and to make room for a more stable mounting structure for the weather station and electrical panel box.

This building was part of the tour during your June 2006 site visit with the CSSA Staff. At that time, it was informally agreed upon that demolition activities would not have a historical impact since the historical significance/relevance of this structure was questionable.

In accordance with Section 800.6 of the Section 106 Regulation, CSSA is requesting that the State Historical Commission (SHPO) review the demolition proposal and provide approval or comments at the earliest opportunity.
