Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA) collected groundwater samples from your well (JW-26) on 12/21/05. These samples were submitted to a laboratory contracted by CSSA's environmental contractor for volatile organic compound (VOC) analysis. This letter provides you with the VOC data from the laboratory results and a formal thank you for your assistance in this groundwater monitoring effort.

An abbreviated summary of analytical results compared to maximum contaminant levels (MCLs) allowed in drinking water by the U.S. EPA under the Safe Drinking Water Act is provided below:

Based on the analytical data, no VOCs related to CSSA's groundwater investigation were identified in water samples from your well. Results from the laboratory analysis are provided as an attachment for the above sampling event.

As part of the ongoing CSSA environmental program, we are continuing to investigate and cleanup VOC source areas on the installation and to track these compounds in groundwater on- and offpost. As part of this effort, we may contact you in the future to schedule another sampling event for the well listed above.
