
Dear Mr. Zerrenner,

Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), U.S. Army, is submitting the 2008 Annual Report - Programmatic Biological Opinion (PBO). This report is a requirement of the above referenced Biological Opinion and provides a brief summary of activities undertaken at Camp Stanley in the past year that have adversely impacted endangered species habitat. To the greatest extent practicable, activities were conducted outside of the endangered species' nesting seasons and outside identified habitat areas. No deceased endangered species were found during this reporting period, no endangered species were noted in project areas, and no habitat was adversely modified.

An endangered avian species survey will be conducted at Camp Stanley during the 2009 field season IAW the referenced Biological Opinion and our Integrated Natural Resources Management Plan (INRMP). The results of this survey will be included in next year's annual report.
