Dear LTC Shirley:

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received the report entitled *Final Area of Concern 48 Delisting Report* dated July 2004. The report concluded that no waste management activity were conducted at Area Of Concern (AOC) 48. As a consequence, the report recommended that AOC 48 should be removed from the list of AOCs. The report also recommended that subsurface analytical results should be included in the data set for consideration in the calculation of CSSA background levels.

The TCEQ has completed its review of the report and accepts/approves the conclusion of the report that AOC 48 should be removed from the list as an area of concern. With respect to your request to include the subsurface analytical results as part of the calculation of CSSA background, the TCEQ cannot approve this request because the report did not include any laboratory results, sampling location, sampling depth, etc. with the report. Please submit a separate "background determination and calculation report" should you decide to incorporate the data set from the subsurface investigation of AOC 48.

To document compliance with the Texas Professional Geoscience Act, the Remediation Division will not review reports and documents received on or after September 1, 2004 that do not contain the seal of a Texas Professional Geoscientist for geoscience services and work. Reports and documents containing geoscience information that are not stamped with a Texas Professional Geoscience seal will be returned to the submitting party.
