The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received the report entitled *Final June 2004 On-Post Quarterly Groundwater Monitoring Report* dated October 2004. The report, received by the TCEQ on December 3, 2004, specified that it has fulfilled the groundwater quarterly reporting requirements of CSSA's Data Quality Objectives.

The TCEQ has completed its review of the report and accepts/approves the report. The TCEQ would like to take this opportunity by requesting CSSA to include maps, in future submittals, showing the locations of the WESTBAY wells with the rest of the facility monitoring wells. The TCEQ also requests presentation of TCE, PCE and other contaminant constituents as isoconcentration maps in addition to narratives (i.e., Section 5.1.2 MCL Exceedances in Monitoring Wells). Lastly, as a one time submittal, CSSA must submit the well diagrams for each of the WESTBAY wells showing and documenting the "screened" intervals.

To document compliance with the Texas Professional Geoscience Act, the Remediation Division will not review reports and documents received on or after September 1, 2004 that do not contain the seal of a Texas Professional Geoscientist for geoscience services and work. Reports and documents containing geoscience information that are not stamped with a Texas Professional Geoscience seal will be returned to the submitting party.
