The Camp Stanley Storage Activity (CSSA), U.S. Army, is providing this letter to inform the TCEQ of CSSA's plan for the movement of approximately 2,500 cubic yards of non-hazardous lead-impacted soils generated from SWMU B-8 to CSSA's East Pasture Firing Range.

CSSA currently has a need for additional cover soils on the small arms firing range berm in the east pasture. This berm was recently modified with non-hazardous soils generated from SWMU B-24 which was authorized to be used at CSSA's East Pasture Firing Range by TCEQ and USEPA during a Technical Interchange Meeting held on April 19, 2006.

To verify SWMU B-8 soils are non-hazardous prior to movement to the East Pasture Firing Range berm, soil samples will be collected and analyzed for TCLP lead at a rate of 1 per 200 cubic yards in accordance with CSSA's approved RFI/IM Waste Management Plan dated May 2006. Some soils may require stabilization with Phosphate Induced Metal Stabilization (PIMS) material or agricultural grade phosphate prior to transporting, in order to ensure that lead-impacted soils meet non-hazardous criteria. Movement of the non-hazardous lead-impacted soils from SWMU B-8 to the associated berm in the East Pasture Firing Range is expected to begin on May 5, 2008.
