The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has completed the review of the above-referenced reports. The reports were submitted in accordance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) Section 3008(h) Administrative Order on Consent (Order) for CSSA, Docket No. RCRA-VI 002(h)99-H FY99, dated May 5, 1999. The Progress Report addresses the project progress at CSSA from January 1, 2014 through June 30, 2014. The RFI Work Plan includes a work plan, field sampling plan, referenced health and safety plans, and a quality assurance project plan. Objectives of the RFI referenced in the RFI Work Plan include identifying possible releases; investigating and preventing migration of contaminants associated with known releases; and ensuring that corrective actions protect human health and the environment.

Based on the information provided, the TCEQ approves the RFI Work Plan and Progress Report with the following comment.

- The TCEQ concurs with the July 25, 2014 EPA correspondence. In the correspondence, the EPA requests that Table 5.1 of the RFI Work Plan include the Maximum Contaminant Levels (MCLs) and/or action levels for the Site contaminants of concern.
