SUBJECT Skip was not available, spoke to Sam Crowther. He said standard exemption applies individually to boilers. You need to get sulfur contents for each fuel used from fuel supplier. Fuel contents can vary immensely within the ASTM guidelines. He suggested I talk to Victoria Shu about other standard exemptions. He also noted that total emissions from the facility cannot exceed 100 tpy; otherwise you trigger federal permit requirements.

(Sulfur PTC = 11.1%)

Spoke to Victoria Shu. She agreed that the nickel pentrate coating process would meet standard exemption #41, with standard exemption #57 as a backup for the two nickel pentrate tanks. She said to get the vapor pressure of the cold oil rinse. If it is very low (less than 0.01 mm Hg) it is not even a source.

Check grit blasting sources with std. exemption 102.

Check degreasers with std. exemption 107.

Fill out PI-7 on vapor degreaser and mail directly to regional office. She suggested we contact the regional office and find out what std. exemptions the facility has. All std. exemptions are filed with the regional office.
