Public Notice Required for Closure

Dear Colonel Schmelling:

With respect to the closure plan originally submitted on August 5, 1993 and revised on December 6, 1995 pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §335.118(b), U.S. Army Camp Stanley Storage Activity is required to do the following:

1. Publish the enclosed notice once in its entirety, at your expense, in a newspaper of general circulation which is regularly published or circulated in the county or the geographical location of the facility;
2. Mail, immediately upon publication, the following items to the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC):
 - a. a clipping of the published notice; and
 - b. the original sworn affidavit from the newspaper giving the date on which the notice was published, using the enclosed affidavit form.

The originals and one copy of these items should be sent to Mr. Luis Campos, Corrective Action Section, at the letter head address. Also, one copy of these items should be sent to the TNRCC Regional Office in your area.

Notice of Partial Facility Closure

Pursuant to 30 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) Section 335.118(b), the Executive Director of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission hereby gives notice of the closure plan originally submitted on August 5, 1993 and revised on December 6, 1995 for the hazardous waste unit operated by U.S. Army Camp Stanley Storage Activity. The facility is located at 25800 Ralph Fair Rd., Boerne, Texas. Pursuant to the closure plan submitted, U.S. Army Camp Stanley Storage Activity intends to close the "B-20 Open Burning/Open Detonation Area" by removing all hazardous waste and removing or remediating contaminated soils at the site in accordance with the Risk Reduction Rules Standard 1 or 2, pursuant to 30 TAC Chapter 335 Subchapters A and S.

The purpose of this notice is to give members of the public the opportunity to submit written comments on the closure plan and request modifications to the plan. Any comments must be submitted within 30 days of the date of publication of this notice to Paul S. Lewis, Manager, Corrective Action Section, Industrial and Hazardous Waste Division, Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, MC-127, P.O. Box 13087, Austin, TX 78711-3087. Pursuant to 30 TAC Section 335.118(b), the Executive Director is required to approve, modify, or disapprove the plan within 90 days of receipt. Copies of the closure plan are open for public inspection at the north Austin office of the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, Park 35, Building D, Room 190N, 12118 North IH-35, Austin, Texas and at the Commission's Region 13 Office, 140 Heimer Rd., Suite 360, San Antonio, Texas 78232- 5042.

In addition, pursuant to 30 TAC Section 335.118(b), the Executive Director may, in response to a request or at his own discretion, hold a public hearing on the closure plan whenever such a hearing might clarify one or more issues concerning the plan. Any request for a public hearing should be submitted within 30 days of the date of publication of this notice to Paul S. Lewis, Manager, Corrective Action Section, Industrial and Hazardous Waste Division, Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission, MC-127, P. O. Box 13087, Austin, Texas 78711-3087, telephone 512/239-2343.
