This is to acknowledge the receipt of your December 4, 1998 letter notifying the Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) that:

- ▶ The mercury vapor lamps which you notified the TNRCC that Camp Stanley will be recycling are not a hazardous waste;
- ▶ Camp Stanley, which is located at 25800 Ralph Fair Road in Boerne, Texas, is not an industrial generator; and
