Dear Mr. Stinson:

The monitoring and reporting requirements for Outfall 002 in the above-referenced permit are hereby suspended as requested in your letter subject to the following conditions:

1. During the period of suspension, the permittee shall not discharge any wastewater from Outfall 002.
2. The suspension of the monitoring and reporting requirements does not: (a) Modify other requirements, or (b) Relieve the permittee of the requirement to submit reports for any period prior to this date.
3. The permittee shall notify the commission forty-five (45) days prior to the activation of the outfall.
