Self Reporting of Exceedance for Maximum Daily Average
and Daily Flow

Dear Executive Director:

Per your requirements set forth in 30 TAC §§319.4-319.12, Camp Stanley Storage Activity, permit number 03849, is self reporting that we had an exceedance of our maximum daily flow and maximum daily average for the month of June 1997. Mr. Arthur Locke, TNRCC San Antonio Regional Office was contacted on 1 July 1997 at approximately 5:00 p.m. to provide our verbal report within the allotted 24 hour period.

Our permit limitations are 0.03 million gallons per day (GPD) daily average and 0.06 million GPD maximum daily flow. During the month of June the San Antonio area experienced very large amounts of rainfall, especially 20 - 22 June 1997. Areas near Camp Stanley recorded 18 inches of rain in a 24 hour period starting 21 June 1997. Our effluents during the month were 0.05 million GPD daily average and .187 million GPD maximum daily flow.

We regret such an event occurred, however, it was beyond our control. It should be noted as well that, on the weekend, Camp Stanley has a limited work force, with only the security guards on duty and seven residences that were occupied during this timeframe.
